Production Lead Supervisor

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITY:

The Coater Production Supervisor oversees manufacturing workflow and personnel in order to meet customer requirements, on time goals, and production needs as outlined in the production schedule and all Coater Unit Requirements.

Essential Functions:

Work involves most of the following:

- Responsible for achieving all departmental business, quality and safety goals established by Management.
- Monitor Coater Equipment to verify quality, productivity, and waste, meet established requirements.
- Totally address all production, scheduling, quality, and maintenance problems.
- Ensure all personnel are properly trained for their positions, safety awareness, coater maintenance and additional current or future, special job related requirements.
- E-mail daily production summary to designated addresses.
- Identify root causes of errors and subsequent corrective action.
- Operate coater if needed and do appropriate monitoring and job approvals.
- Assist on all staffing level requirements
- · Monitor daily active consumption dashboards.
- · Identify production improvement opportunities.
- Verify data collection entries are correct.
- Review efficiency and downtime key indicators on a daily basis and institute corrective action when appropriate.
- Drive Lean and Quality Management Systems initiatives.
- Assist on special projects and perform other duties as required by Management.

Other Functions:

- Acts as a backup for Business Unit Manager.
- Attend meetings, conferences and seminars.
- Is assigned to special projects.
- Perform related duties as required.

The duties listed above are intended only as illustrative of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar or a logical assignment to the position.

- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment and juggle multiple priorities.
- Able to think quickly, assess a situation and make a sound decision.
- Able to use technology to optimize efficiency and effectiveness.
- Solid written and verbal communication, listening, organization and priority setting skills.
- Listens well and retains instructions; accepts constructive feedback from supervisor.
- · Solid critical thinking and problem solving skills.
- Excellent analytical, mathematical, and computations skills.
- Assertive, self-directed; able to work without supervision.

Mental and physical requirements:

- Must be highly mobile, able to access all areas of the premises;
